2. Artist: Michelangelo (Italian 1475-1564). Cast from the original plaster mold taken by the Fonderia Artistica Ferdinando Marinelli, Florence, Italy in 1932 of Michelangelo's original marble "Pieta" c 1498-99, Basilica of St Peter, Vatican.
3. Dimensions: H 165.1 cm x W 194.9 cm x D 69.1 cm x Weight 700kg.
4. Material: Bronze, brown patina.
